Kevin Fenton, professor of choral conducting and ensembles, conducts the University Singers, Graduate Chamber Choir and the Vocal Jazz Ensemble at Florida State University. Choirs under his direction performed for regional and national conventions of ACDA, CMS and MENC on ten occasions, including the University Singers performance at the ACDA National Convention in 2013.

A champion of new music, Dr. Fenton has conducted over twenty premiere performances, including Troy Robertson's "This Mystery (2013); Dan Forrest's "Long Long Ago" (2013); Eric Barnum's "In Paradisum" (2010); and Sydney Guillaume's "Au-Déla du Chagrin."

He has conducted in thirty-six states, including twenty all-state honor choirs; and for festivals in Beijing, Nairobi, and Prague. Dr. Fenton has received several awards for his teaching, including Delta Omicron Music Professor of the Year; the FSU Award for Excellence in Teaching and Florida's Hugoboom Award. Kevin is the Artistic Director for the Festival Singers of Florida and the president of ACDA's Southern Division.
